The Lilly Scholarship application is now active. The Lilly Scholarship provides full tuition, required fees, and a special allocation of up to \$900 per year for required books and required equipment for four years. Scholarship recipients must apply for a full-time course of study to begin in the fall of 2020 at an accredited public or private college or university in Indiana. To apply, students must have at least a 3.25 GPA and an ACT of 22 or (P)SAT of 1050. The application is available now through **September 9, 2019**.
