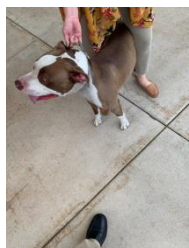

Open web browser and type <http://www.wrightdj.com> in the address box and press the “Enter” button on your keyboard or click the “Go” button with your mouse. This should take you to the Wright Entertainment home page.

On the main page on the right side you find the button that says "[Guest login](#)" This will take you to the login page.

1. Enter the event date **September 28, 2018** and your **password**, which is **MHC2019**. When you have entered all information correctly, click the “Login” button.
