Rosita

Rosita is a turquoise, bilingual monster who first appeared on *Sesame Street* in 1991 in Episode 2888 (Season 23). Hailing from Mexico, her full name is *Rosita, la Monstrua de las Cuevas* (Rosita, the Monster of the Caves).[1] She is five years old,[2] and celebrates her birthday on December 7. She is the second bilingual Muppet to recur on the show (after Osvaldo the Grouch), speaking both English and Spanish. The idea of a bilingual Muppet character for the show was conceived as early as 1990 by Jim Henson, who allowed Carmen Osbahr to pick what type of character it would be. A monster was ultimately chosen, fearing an indigenous animal might be viewed as politically incorrect. After Henson's passing, Osbahr met with some of the show's creative team to finally develop the character as she became.[4]
